Sunday, September 21 - Centennial Celebration

On Sunday, September 21, there will be one Liturgy at 10:30 a.m. Metropolitan Archbishop Stefan Soroka will be the celebrant and homilist, Metropolitan Archbishop *Emeritus* Stephen Sulyk and Bishop John Bura will concelebrate, along with priests and deacons.

A procession from the rectory will begin at 10:15 a.m. The procession will include altar boys, sodalists, the Centennial Icon carried by St. Ann's Society members, Holy Name Society Members and the clergy. Those in the procession should meet in front of the rectory before 10:10 a.m. In case of rain, please meet in the church hall.

Communion will be distributed at four stations by bishops and priests; communicants are asked to use the center aisle only to come up for communion, and to return to their seats by the side aisles.

Following the Liturgy coffee will be available in the church hall. School hall front doors will be open at 12:30 p.m.; the banquet begins at 1:30 p.m. As you enter the hall, a seating chart is available to locate your table number. You are asked to enter the hall through the front entrance. Do not use the kitchen door. Anyone with a disability who can not walk down stairs may enter through the playground school entrance and proceed to the front entrance of the hall.

Seminarian to be Ordained Subdeacon Here

On Sunday, November 2, 2008, Seminarian Paul J. Makar will be ordained Subdeacon. The Liturgy will be held at 11:00 a.m. with the choir singing the responses. There will be no Liturgy at 9:00 a.m. A luncheon will be held following the Liturgy. Mark the date on your calendar!

Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Icons of the Feast usually portray St. Macarius in the center of the Icon, elevating the Holy Cross and showing it to the people.



This elevation or uplifting of the Cross shows its prominence as the sign of victory. Hence the name "Exaltation" or "Elevation of the Holy Cross." St. Constantine the Emperor, and St. Helena, his mother, are

frequently shown, although some icons depict only St. Helena. Gathered about the Cross with St. Macarius and St. Helena are bishops, priests, and hymnographers. With them, too, we are joined in oneness of mind and purpose as we sing: "We bow to Your cross, O Lord, and we praise Your holy resurrection."
