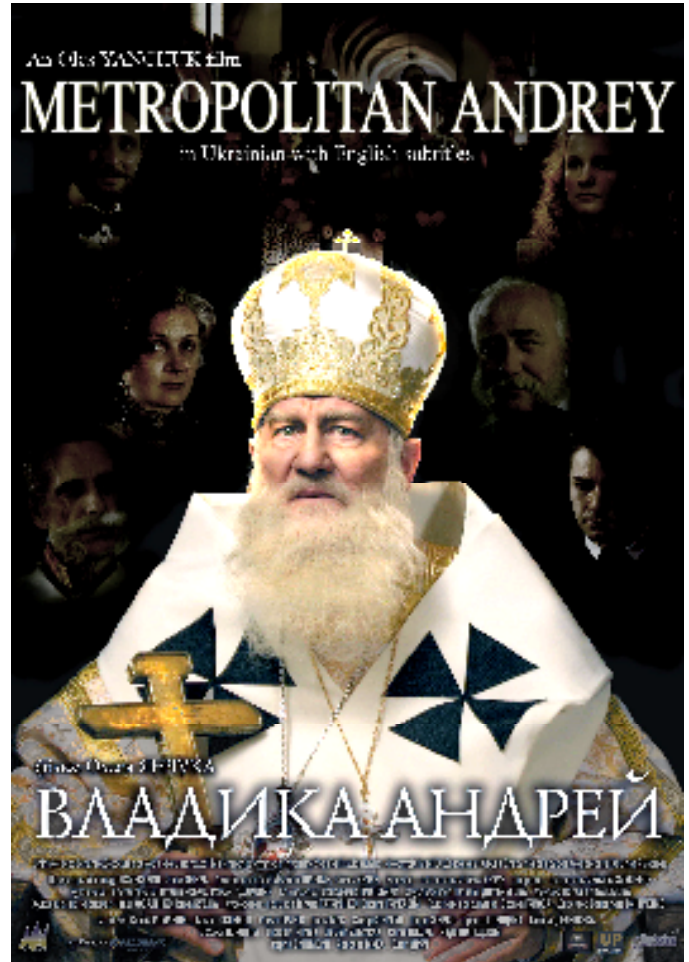
**Special Sale - Ukrainian Items, Books, Etc.**
