A Prayerful Atmosphere

There are people who come to church early to pray and meditate before the Divine Services begin. There are also those who choose to stay afterwards to do the same. Please refrain from unnecessary talking, both before and after the Divine Services, so that an appropriate atmosphere of prayer in God's Holy House may be maintained.

Some Things You Should Know While in Church

- **Standing vs. Sitting**

The traditional posture for prayer and worship in the Ukrainian Church has been to stand. In Ukraine, there are usually no pews in the churches. Chairs or benches on the side walls are usually reserved for the elderly and infirm. In North America, we have tended to build our churches with pews, and since we have them, we need to figure out when we may sit and when we should stand. First of all, it is fully acceptable to stand for the entire service. Note that the priest and servers stand for the entire service on Sundays. If you prefer this, it would be better to find a place closer to the back or side of the church so as not to stand out or block someone's view. When should you definitely stand? Always during the Gospel reading, the Little and Great Entrances, the Anaphora (on Sundays), the Distribution of Holy Communion, whenever the priest gives a blessing, and the Dismissal. In many parishes, the Divine Liturgy books in the pew have suggested times when sitting is acceptable. Follow those instructions (it's probably safer than to follow what the people are doing in the first couple rows). When in doubt, stand.

- **Lighting Candles**

Lighting candles is an important part of Ukrainian worship. We light them as we pray, making an offering to accompany our prayers. Eastern Christians typically light candles when coming to the church - and that is usually the best time to light them, but there are times when candles should not be lit. It is not proper to light candles during the Epistle or Gospel readings, during the Little or Great Entrances, the sermon, and most of the times when the faithful are standing. If you find yourself arriving to church after the Liturgy has begun, a good rule of thumb to remember is - if everyone is standing, wait until they are sitting to light a candle (unless they are sitting for the sermon, of course).

- **Pentecost Sunday is Today.**

In our Eastern Churches, we traditionally use the color GREEN to celebrate the sending of the Holy Spirit. After liturgies, we will have Anointing of Holy Oil - Myrovania.
