Church Membership: Membership in the Ukrainian Catholic Church includes the contribution of your annual dues, continual sustaining donations to your Church, and active participation in church activities. To make sure your contributions are recorded properly, please use your Church envelopes.

Baptisms: Parents should attend church regularly for at least six months prior to the birth of the child. A baptism should be scheduled immediately after the birth of the child.

First Penance and Solemn First Holy Communion: Anyone who plans to receive First Penance and Solemn First Holy Communion must attend Religious Instruction and Regular Liturgy with their family for at least two (2) years prior to these events.

Confession: Confessions are held 1/2 hour before every liturgy and other times by request.

Marriages: All couples contemplating marriage in our church are required to attend Pre-Cana counseling sessions. Please contact Fr. Ivan as soon as you make plans to wed.
