Church Membership: Membership in the Ukrainian Catholic Church includes the contribution of your annual dues, continual sustaining donations to your Church, and active participation in church activities. To make sure your contributions are recorded properly, please use your Church envelopes.

Church Dues: Annual church dues are \$24.00 per adult parishioner or \$48.00 per family (husband, wife and children under 18 yrs.) Use the blue envelopes in your box of donation envelopes, \$2.00 per month, or pay more than one month at a time. Some people make one payment of \$24.00 annually. (If only the husband or wife has envelopes, be sure to pay \$4.00 per month or \$48.00 annually.) Children 18 years or older should have their own adult envelopes.
