***Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord,  
God and Savior Jesus Christ***

The Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord, God and Savior Jesus Christ is celebrated each year on August 6. The feast commemorates the transfiguration or metamorphosis of Christ on Mount Tabor, when our Lord appeared in His divine glory before the Apostles Peter, James, and John.

In keeping with our Ukrainian tradition, BLESSING OF FRUIT will take place Monday after the 9:00 a.m. liturgy.

***Blessing of Fruit***

The feast of the Transfiguration falls during that time when the fruits of the earth reach maturity. From the earliest times in the Eastern Church, on this day fruit is blessed in thanksgiving to God for the first-fruits of the earth. This custom was adopted by the Christian Church from the Old Testament which prescribed that fruit be brought to the Temple of the Lord.

In the Book of Exodus we read: "You shall carry the first-fruits of the corn of your ground to the house of the Lord your God." (23,19)
