ASK THE PASTOR: What is the Presanctified Liturgy?

The Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts is an evening service. It is the solemn lenten Vespers with the administration of Holy Communion added to it. There is no consecration of the eucharistic gifts at the presanctified liturgy. Holy Communion is given from the eucharistic gifts sanctified on the previous Sunday at the celebration of the Divine Liturgy.

Lenten Regulations

Strict Fast and abstinence from meat, eggs and dairy products on the 1st Day of Lent and on Good Friday, abstinence from meat only on all Fridays of Lent as well as Holy Saturday is obligatory. Voluntary abstinence from meat on Wednesdays of Lent is also encouraged, but not obligatory. Reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist during the Paschal Season (from the onset of Lent to the Wednesday before Ascension Thursday) is required. Participation in the Lenten Services is encouraged. Fasting and abstinence are not binding on persons 60 or older, the poor, sick, nursing or pregnant women, children below the age of 14 and those who engage in physically hard labor. Prayer and alms-giving oblige all.

The Great Fast is Coming

Great Lent is just around the corner and will officially begin on Monday, February 11. During Lenten season in our church we will celebrate Stations of the Cross on Tuesdays at 6:30 p.m. Then on Fridays, we will celebrate the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts at 6:30 p.m. followed by Religious Class. On Saturdays, we will celebrate a Divine Liturgy for the Souls enrolled in Sorokousty at 9:00 a.m. All parishioners are urged to resolve to make their best effort to attend at least 7 of these services during the Great Fast, especially those in which we remember our deceased loved ones. All are obliged to attend the Divine Liturgy on Sundays.
