What is the meaning of clergy vestments?

Vestments serve to remind the clergy that they are to come into God's presence not as they are (with ordinary street dress) but better than they are, i.e. clothed with Christ, His love, forgiveness and humility. Vestments are much like icons. They are like windows through which we look to see Christ. Vestments serve to hide and submerge the personality of the priest so that worshippers, seeing Christ through the vestments, may know that it is He (Jesus) who teaches and sanctifies through the priest. The deacon wears two vestments, a priest five, and the bishop has seven vestments comparable to the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. As the ordained clergy vests himself before worship, he says a special prayer before he puts on each article of clothing.
