82nd Annual Pilgrimage To The Mother Of God:**Sisters Of The Order Of Saint Basil The Great**

This year's 82nd Annual Pilgrimage honoring the Mother of God will be held on Sunday, October 6, 2013 on the grounds of the Motherhouse of the Sisters of Saint Basil the Great in Fox Chase Manor, PA. The theme of this year's Pilgrimage is "Accepting the Cross: Martyrs of the Ukrainian Catholic Church". The day begins with the Mystery of Reconciliation starting at 9:00 a.m. A Divine Liturgy will be celebrated at 11:30 am by Archbishop Stefan Soroka and accompanying hierarchy and clergy. The homilist for the Divine Liturgy and Moleben will be His Grace, Bishop Borys Gudziak, Ph.D., Ukrainian Eparchial Bishop in France, Benelux and Switzerland. Lunch will be available afterwards, featuring traditional Ukrainian food. The day will conclude with a prayer service (Moleben) at 4:00 p.m. in the Grotto. Pope Francis Appoints Special Envoy to Attend 1025th Anniversary of Baptism of Ukraine-Rus

Pope Francis appointed Cardinal Audrys Juozas Bačkis, Archbishop Emeritus of Vilnius, as his special envoy to attend the celebrations marking the 1025th anniversary of the Baptism of Ukraine-Rus, scheduled for August 17-18, 2013 in Kyiv, Radio Vatican reports.

The celebrations will include a meeting of the Synod of Bishops, a national pilgrimage, which will be attended by faithful of Ukraine and the diaspora, and the consecration of the Patriarchal Cathedral of the Resurrection of Christ.

As the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church (UGCC) Information Department reported earlier, Greek Catholics will celebrate the anniversary of the baptism in August, not July. This was explained at a press conference in Kyiv by Patriarch Sviatoslav Shevchuk, who said the tradition of celebrating the two events together - the feast day of Prince Volodymyr and the anniversary of the Baptism of Rus-Ukraine - is a tradition of the Russian Church. "Combining these two events was intended to emphasize the state nature of the state religion of Moscow Orthodoxy. We are heirs of Volodymyr's baptism and the Church of Kyiv. And we kept the ancient Kyivan tradition, according to which the Baptism of Ukraine-Rus is celebrated every year on August 14 - the day of the Holy Maccabean Martyrs when Dormition Fast begins and the day of the so-called Augustivskyi water blessing. We honor the tradition of the Russian Church, but in our church we uphold the tradition of the Kyivan Church, so our celebration coincide with this date," said the head of the UGCC.

Blessed John Paul II Will Be Declared a Saint

The Vatican has approved the last miracle needed to confirm John Paul II's sainthood. All that's needed is a signature from Pope Francis.

The process of declaring former pope John Paul II a saint took a major step forward Tuesday, when the board of theologians of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints approved his second miracle. Two confirmed miracles are needed for sainthood; they must be "instantaneous, permanent, and with no scientific explanation." The first, which was necessary for his beatification occurred "just six months after his death in 2005." That was the healing of a French nun, Sister Marie Simon-Pierre, whose recovery from Parkinson's disease after praying for the late John Paul II's "intercession" had no medical explanation. The second miracle reportedly took place on the very day that John Paul II was beatified in a lavish ceremony in St Peter's Square on May 1, 2011, and was the healing of a woman from Costa Rica.
