PASTOR'S CORNER

Is a telling a white lie a sin? If you have to do something wrong to accomplish something good, it isn't a sin, is it?

Colossians 3:9 Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices.

Yes, telling a 'white lie' is a sin. Lies are lies, no matter the color or lack of it, and lying is a sin. Sometimes we think telling a lie is necessary to accomplish a good result but that doesn't make it any less a lie. Just because it's more convenient to lie than to tell the truth, just because it may be easier to lie than to argue or dissuade doesn't make it acceptable before God. And just because a lie would seem a better answer to another person, in order to avoid an unpleasant consequence, doesn't make it any less a lie, less sinful or less wrong.

Why wouldn't the priest bless my ring when I asked him?

What kind of ring would you want to have blessed? The only rings we bless in Church are wedding rings. Wedding rings are blessed at the time of the wedding. All other rings are only jewelry and decorations.

What's the difference between betrothal and engagement?

Engagement is an exchange of promises, usually symbolized by exchanging a ring or rings, between two people who decide to marry. These promises are not formalized or legally binding. Betrothal is the first part of the Sacrament of Marriage. When you are betrothed to someone in the liturgy of the church, those promises are legally binding and forever.

Why is it forbidden to bless homes during Lent?

It isn't forbidden. House-blessing just isn't usually done in Lenten times because of its festive nature. It's incongruous to sing "When You, O Lord was baptized in the Jordan," outside the feast, especially during Lent. In Lent, the Church services are more frequent and longer, and the priest would have to juggle his regular duties with Lenten services and house-blessings. It's too much for one man to handle.
