Ukrainian Independence Day Flag Raising

The annual celebration of Ukrainian Independence Day took place on Sunday, August 23, 2015 with a flag-raising ceremony on the parish grounds of our parish. The day began with a Divine Liturgy held at 9:00 a.m. and blessing of a new flag. After the service, the youngest parishioners of the church carried the Ukrainian sky-blue and yellow flag to the flagpole in front of the parish school. The parish choir “ Boyan” sang “ God Bless America” and a short program was held. Rev. Ivan Turyk opened the program with a prayer and then Mr. Bohdan Dydyk offered very thoughtful and emotional remarks on the significance of Ukrainian Independence Day and on the responsibility of the descendants here in the USA to do whatever we can to ensure Ukraine’s freedom and democracy. Following remarks, the Ukrainian flag was raised to the singing of the Ukrainian national anthem. At the conclusion of the ceremony, three white doves symbolizing Love, Hope, and Faith were released to promote peace in Ukraine.
