Generations of Faith Program

Our parish will hold the seventh "Generations of Faith," religious education program. If you have not yet participated or are new to Assumption Church, GOF, as we like to call it, brings together parishioners of all ages to learn more about their Catholic Faith, our heritage and traditions. Families with children of all ages (young ones and teens) are welcome to participate. On Sunday, November 29, 2015 there will be only one bilingual Divine Liturgy at 9:00 a.m. followed by GOF. Since this year Ukrainian Catholics are celebrating the 150th anniversary of Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky's birth, the theme for the program will be "Heroic Virtues" of the Venerable Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky. We will have two speakers, Mrs. Melanie Fedynyshyn and Mrs. Olha Lytvyn, refreshments, and a good time as one parish family. You don't need to register just come and join us.

Cataract Press

The Nativity Fast begins November 15th, and concludes at the Divine Liturgy on Christmas day, December 25th. This 40-day fast is given to prepare us for the celebration of the Lord's birth in the flesh. During this time we should not only modify our diet so we can modify the movements of our hearts, but we should also seek to avail ourselves of the Sacraments of Holy Confession and Communion.

His Beatitude Patriarch Sviatoslav Shevchuk visits our community.

The world spiritual father of the Ukrainian Catholic Church, His Beatitude Sviatoslav Shevchuk visited ACS for the first time on Nov. 11, 2015 and gave his blessing to all teachers and students. During the visit to the school, His Beatitude Shevchuk was presented with traditional bread and salt by students dressed in traditional garb. A short program was prepared to greet our spiritual leader and after that, students grilled him on a variety of topics in English, Spanish and Ukrainian. Aid for Ukraine

We all share heartfelt concern for our brothers and sisters suffering the ravages of terrorist actions by insurgent separatist groups in eastern Ukraine. Ukrainian citizens and members of the military have suffered significantly. Some have made the ultimate sacrifice in the loss of life or suffered injury. Many people are being forced to flee their homes. During the recent visit of His Beatitude Sviatoslav to our parish, he was presented with \$1,000 to help Ukrainians who are suffering from war in Ukraine.
