Today: Sunday of All Saints

The Sunday after Pentecost is dedicated in our Holy Church to the remembrance of all those that have gone before us, who have fulfilled God's plan for humanity here on earth, who took up that call from God to join Him, and the many who suffered greatly and died for their faith. It is on these days that we not only commemorate those saints who are well known to us, but we also commemorate those whose names we don't know.

The Peter and Paul (Apostles) Fast

The Apostles Fast begins this evening (May 22) and lasts until June 28. Fast and abstinence on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, with a mitigated abstinence on Tuesday and Thursday. The Ukrainian Metropolia in America has identified this period as a penitential season (Canon 880 #2). Unlike Great Lent, this fast may be observed voluntarily.
