Candles!

Someone once called the Eastern Catholic Church "The Candlelight Kingdom." We have candles at Easter, candles at baptisms, candles on the altar table, candles before icons, candles everywhere. Lighting a candle is like praying because we never light a candle without praying. Lighting a candle reminds us that Jesus is "the light that shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it" (John 1:5). Lighting a candle reminds us that Jesus is the light of the world. "Whoever follows Him does not walk in darkness but has the light of life" (John 8:12). Many Christians light a candle when they first come to church. Doing this reminds us that when we were baptized we received Jesus Who is the light of the world. Like Him we are to be lighting candles of hope and love in the lives of people. As we light a candle before entering church we can pray the beautiful words of the Psalmist: *The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?* (Psalm 27:1)
