The Holy Mystery of Marriage (from the Catechism of the Ukrainian Catholic Church) - Marriage Is a Mystery of Love between a Man and a Woman # 472. The Church gives witness to this in a prayer of the Rite of Crowning: "Holy God, you created man from the dust and from his side fashioned a woman as a suitable helpmate for him, for such was the good pleasure of your majesty that man should not be alone on earth." In their gender differentiation, a man and a woman complete one another, creating an indissoluble union of one body.

- Men, women, and children: please dress modestly for services. The general rule for men and women is to dress appropriately, modestly and respectfully, because we stand before the living God. The people of our church wear everything from casual pants to suits, long dresses to skirts, and shirts with or without ties. Some women wear head coverings, but this is not required. Men are asked not to wear head coverings (baseball caps, etc.) in the nave, the main part of the church.
- Please remove lip balm or lipstick before receiving Communion or kissing the holy icons, Chalice, or Gospel.
