**Patriarch Sviatoslav to make Marian August Pilgrimage**

Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate, joyfully announce that His Beatitude, Patriarch Sviatoslav Shevchuk will preside at the 64th Holy Dormition Pilgrimage in Sloatsburg, NY on August 11-12, 2018. Our parish will have a bus to go to the Pilgrimage on SUNDAY, AUGUST 12. We will be able to participate at the Pontifical Divine Liturgy at 10:30 a.m., receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Blessing of the Sick. We will also pray the Stations of the Cross and the Moleben to the Mother of God at 3:30 p.m. The bus will leave from the front of the church at 8:00 a.m. and after completion of all services at 5:00 p.m. return to Perth Amboy. The tickets for the bus are \$20 for an adult person and the money will be collected on the bus. Bus seating is limited and will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. The bus Registration Form will be available in the church vestibule in July-August.
