Why do some Churches use white wine and some red wine?

There's actually no rubric about what color the wine that is used in mass should be. Because it becomes the precious Blood, people often associate the color red with the wine but the fact is that it can be either. The wine is changed entirely in the Consecration anyway, keeping the appearance of wine, but being, in reality something entirely different - the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ. Therefore, the color of wine used is truly inconsequential. The only requirement for the wine used at Liturgy is that it is true wine, made only from grapes (no extra flavors) and that it has an alcohol content between 8-18%.
