The 16th Sunday after Pentecost.

In today's Gospel, the Lord is giving us the "the golden rule": as we do to others, so the others will do to us. The way we treat our neighbours, we give them the right to treat us. Very often we seem to have a pretention to others: someone didn't look at us the right way, someone didn't say the right thing to us, or reacted wrongly to us, or did not present themselves correctly before us. We are often hurt by the deeds of others towards us, but we many times overlook the way we hurt others. The rule that the Lord gives us is very straightforward: that what we want for people to do to us, we should do to them. If we want people to forgive us - than we should forgive them, if we want people to love us - than we should love them, if we don't want people to do bad things to us - then we should not do bad things to them, if we want respect from others - then we should respect others. So therefore, what we do to others, the others will do to us.

October is Youth Month.

"Remember now your Creator in the days of your youth." (Ecclesiastes 12:1) This month, we celebrate the contributions and needs of our youth. Therefore, we call upon our youth to share in the many opportunities to minister in the Church. The youth are encouraged to read the Epistle, chant and sing in the choir, help distribute bulletins, assist the priest with his work at the parish. The Protection of the Theotokos

On Tuesday, October 1st, we will celebrate the Protection of the Mother of God, traditionally called "Pokrova." To celebrate this feast day, we will have Liturgy in the Morning at 8:00 am and Vespers Divine Liturgy at 7:00 p.m. The Feast of the Protection-Pokrova commemorates the appearance of the Most Holy Theotokos in the Church of Blachernae in Constantinople in the early sixth century, spreading out her veil over people, signifying her unceasing protection of all Christians. Because of this we keep a yearly feast of gratitude, imploring our Lady never to cease sheltering us in her mighty prayers.
