# BEING CLOSE TO GOD BY GOING TO CHURCH Why Do We Stress Church Attendance?

The Church is literally the Body of Christ. We believe that the same glorious presence of God, the Shekinah Glory, that dwelt on the Ark of the Covenant now resides on each altar in every Catholic Temple. "God is with us, understand all ye nations." Isaiah 8:10, as the hymn from Great Compline says.
