THE PASCHAL KISS

Our traditional kissing of the Holy Cross or Resurrection Icon, takes place after the Resurrection Matins, and after each Liturgy. The faithful approach the priest by way of the center aisle. While kissing the Holy Cross held by the priest, he greets us with the joyful news:

CHRISTOS VOSKRES! – CHRIST IS RISEN!

We should reply by professing our faith, and saying:

VOISTYNU VOSKRES! – INDEED HE IS RISEN!
