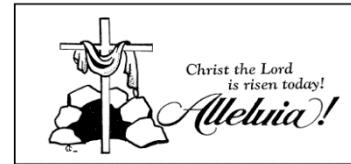

**Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Ukrainians!**

Thanks to US Immigration lawyers Vitaliia Yurchak, Olga Khomyak and Olena Sharvan for holding a meeting at Assumption Catholic Church in Perth Amboy, NJ and informing people that Ukrainians living in the USA will soon be eligible for temporary protected status. They were very easy to speak with and very knowledgeable of the ins and outs of the process. Individuals eligible for TPS under this designation must have continuously resided in the United States since March 1, 2022. TPS offers protection from deportation and a work permit. If you need help with immigration, please call them and they will advise you based on the law and its applicability.

**Volunteers bake traditional paskas and bread.**

The smell of freshly baked bread filled the air inside and around the Assumption Ukrainian Catholic Church in Perth Amboy, NJ. Once inside the church's kitchen, the source of the aroma is soon revealed as several pans of Ukrainian traditional Easter bread (paska) are removed from the oven. Inside the tiny church kitchen, a well organized group of women and men go about the different tasks of preparing more bread for the oven. In two days, 130 paskas and 100 small breads were made under direction of Colette Baginsky and her helpers: Melanie, Alla, Lisa, Mary, John, John, Gabriella and others.

**Delivering Aid to Ukraine.**

Assumption Parish and School in Perth Amboy, NJ have been collecting medical supplies for the past month and now we are happy to announce that the first shipment (27 boxes - 987 lb) of medical supplies arrived in Ukraine and was transferred to the medical hospital in the city of Dnipro. Thanks to Bishop Hryhoriy Komar, an Auxiliary bishop of Sambir-Drohobych Eparchy for his assistance with accepting packages and delivering them to Eastern Ukraine, where help is needed the most.

Recently, (713 lb) of medical supplies were also shipped to Bishop Bohdan Manyshyn, an Auxiliary Bishop of Stryj Eparchy and (470 lb) of medical supplies were sent to Ivano-Frankivsk hospital. It cost us \$2,366 to ship two pallets of supplies.

Thanks to Meest-America who shipped over 60 boxes of our humanitarian aid packages for Ukraine at a discounted price. Thank you to our many parishioners and friends who so generously contributed to the Humanitarian Aid Fund for Ukraine. Together to Victory!
