Our warmest greetings are extended once again to all visitors and guests who are participating in Divine Liturgy. It is always a joy to have you praying with us. Our Pastor, Fr. Ivan Turyk is on vacation through August 19. Today, Rev. Vsevolod Shevchuk of Akron, OH is substituting for him and we extend to him our warm welcome.

The Feast of Assumption (Dormition of Theotokos)

The Falling-asleep of the Theotokos sometimes also called the Assumption - is celebrated on the fifteenth of August, preceded by a two-week fast. This feast commemorates the death, resurrection and glorification of Christ's mother. It proclaims that Mary has been "assumed" by God into the heavenly kingdom of Christ in the fullness of her spiritual and bodily existence. This Feast is a second Pascha-a passage from death to life-because we believe that Mary, like her Son, has passed through death and has risen body and soul. In our parish, the Feast of the Dormition will be commemorated on Monday, August 15, with Divine Liturgy at 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Remember that this is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Blessing of Flowers.

In the Byzantine Church we bless flowers on this festival, not simply because they were found in the tomb of the Virgin Mary, but because they are the seeds of next year's plantings. What we see in any bloom now is the seed of another one to come, and therefore a strong symbol of resurrection. Besides seeds, we also bless herbs on this day. The prayers speak of all these things, flowers, herbs and seeds, as medicine. There is a healing that comes from death, as contradictory as that might sound. St. Gregory of Nyssa once referred to death as "*the final remedy*." Things which cannot be set right in this world can be made right in the next. So don't forget to bring a vase or bouquet of flowers for blessing.


