Report, Humanitarian Aid for Ukraine.

Despite no power, water or services and daily
shelling, Ukrainian people continue fighting until the
country wins the war. To them, victory means retaking all
territory seized by Russia since 2014. While the Ukrainians
have tasted victory on the battlefield, the war is far from
over. The most recent spate of Russian ballistic missile
strikes have crippled almost half of Ukraine's energy
system and caused power blackouts across the country.
People need our continual prayers and support.

Tremendous THANKS to all of you for your most

people in time of war. This is the most recent report of
monetary distributions from our parish:
