Pastor's Corner

Today is Pentecost Sunday which is reminding us that we received amazing gifts from the Holy Spirit on the day of our Baptism and our Confirmation.

They are not material gifts, like toys, video games or kitchen appliances that you might get for your birthday. Those gifts just stay on the outside. They don't really sink into who you are.

- Can you go to the store and buy a box of braveness? So that you can eat it and suddenly you become brave? Of course not!
- Can you go to the store and buy a box of wisdom? You eat a few bits of these and suddenly you become capable of judging things like a wise person? Of course not!
- Or imagine, you had a special cream in the pharmacy called piety; and it makes you feel truly reverent and easily able to pray to God the Father? Of course not!

Let us focus on the gifts of the Holy Spirit. What are they? Do you remember? The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord. Which one of these gifts did you receive from the Holy Spirit lately? Here is my conclusion. Every day, you use these gifts from the Holy Spirit, whether you know it or not. It is like breathing.
