TODAY: Sunday of All Saints.

The first Sunday after the Feast of Holy Pentecost is observed by the Ukrainian Catholic Church as the Sunday of All Saints. This day is designated as a commemoration of all of the Saints, all the Righteous, the Prophets, Apostles, Martyrs, Confessors, Shepherds, Teachers, and Holy Monastics, both men and women alike, known and unknown, who have been added to the choirs of the Saints and shall be added, from the time of Adam until the end of the world, who have been perfected in piety and have glorified God by their holy lives. Since many Saints are unknown, and their number has increased with time, and will continue to increase until the end of time, the Church has appointed that once a year a common commemoration be made of all the Saints.

Assumption Catholic School Graduation Class.

Twenty four strong, smart, funny, kind, helpful teenagers prayed together this Saturday morning with their teachers and families joining them at the Divine Liturgy. They received their diplomas from Mrs. Shumny and Father Ivan, and then it was picture time. Afterwards, students and their families came back to school for their breakfast and awards ceremony. Sodality new member installation.

For as long as can be remembered, Sodality had been part of our Parish and School community. Years ago (in the 1950's) Mrs. Pat Krieger guided young ladies in their spiritual development. Mrs. Marcella Massapust replaced Mrs. Krieger and continued her good work. Through the years, Sodality girls have worn capes and beanies of blue and white. While that is no longer the case, what has remained constant are the medals each girl receives when they pledge their loyalty to the Blessed Mother. The Sodality is a group of young ladies who are committed to growing in personal holiness and serving their school community through their consecration to Jesus through Mary. The 15 young women of this Sodality, under spiritual guidance of Sisters Servants of the Lord and the Virgin of Matará were preparing for this day for the whole year. They attended meetings, learned songs and deepened their knowledge of the Blessed Mother of God. During the consecration ceremony, the candidates made their Marian pledge and received a medal. They also received a blue blessed garment sewn by Sisters, as an outward sign of their consecration with the Sodality.
