Marriage Banns

The banns of marriage are announced for ALEX HREBESHCHENKO and MARTA GALADZHUN who plan to be united in the Holy Sacrament of Matrimony in our parish in November. Anyone having knowledge of any obstacles to the proposed marriage has an obligation in conscience to make it known to the pastor as soon as possible.

65th Anniversary of Philadelphia Metropolia.

On July 10, 1958, Pope Pius XII, in the apostolic constitution Apostolicam hanc, officially established the new ecclesiastical province Ukrainian Catholic Metropolia of Philadelphia - comprising the Philadelphia and Stamford exarchates. The act formalized the Province of the Ukrainian Church in America as a fully structured part of the Eternal Church, a recognized province of the universal Catholic Church, and no longer a temporary exarchate.

The formal installation of Bohachevsky in the new see occurred three months. Bohachevsky chose November 1 as the date for his installation ceremonies, symbolically reinforcing the connection between his elevation to metropolitan and the death of Metropolitan Sheptytsky (November 1, 1944), as well as Ukraine's steps to establish itself as a body politic on November 1, 1918, when Western Ukrainians proclaimed their independence from the Habsburg Empire.
