**Welcome to our parish Bishop Hryhoriy Komar**

Bishop Hryhoriy is a Ukrainian Greek Catholic hierarch as the Titular Bishop of Acci and Auxiliary bishop of Sambir - Drohobych since 25 June 2014. Bishop Komar, after graduating school education, joined the Theological Seminary in Lviv and then continued his studies in the Pontifical Oriental Institute in Rome, Italy. After returning to Ukraine he was ordained as deacon on February 12, 2001 and as priest on April 22, 2001, while served as teacher, prefect and subsequently (from July 2003 until June 2014) vice-rector in the Theological Seminary in Drohobych. At the same time, during 2004-2014 he served as a parish priest in the different parishes in Drohobych. On June 25, 2014, he was confirmed by Pope Francis as an Auxiliary Bishop of Sambir - Drohobych, Ukraine and Titular Bishop of Acci. On August 22, 2014, he was consecrated as bishop by His Beatitude -Sviatoslav Shevchuk and other hierarchs of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church
