Burning Candles in the Church

One of the devotional practices in our Church is the beautiful custom of burning candles in front of sacred shrines, icons or relics. When attending the Divine Liturgy on Sunday or any Worship Service, the believer may obtain a candle(s) next to the candle stand in front of the church, accompanied by a donation. The faithful will then light the candle, make the sign of the cross, say a prayer and return to the pew. Please note, according to Ukrainian Catholic Church tradition, all candles must be lit before or after the Liturgy. Those desiring to light candles in memory of loved ones or friends are also welcome to light them after receiving Holy Communion.
