**Beeswax Candles**

Pure beeswax candles are made from combs of beehives. They are beautiful to look at, of a natural substance and delicately honey scented. When the Fathers of the Church are speaking of candles they are referring to beeswax candles. The Pure Wax extracted by Bees from Flowers symbolizes the Pure Flesh of Christ received from His Virgin Mother, the Wick signifies the Soul of Christ, and the Flame represents His Divinity. In our church we are using beeswax candles along with electric ones. At this point it seems necessary to post this reminder—there is a suggested donation of \$1 requested per electric and beeswax candle.
