THE DORMITION OF THE MOHTER OF GOD.

The Feast of the Dormition or Falling asleep of the Theotokos is celebrated on the 15th of August. This feast, which is also known as the Assumption, commemorates the death, resurrection and glorification of Christ's mother. It proclaims that Mary has been "assumed" by God into the Heavenly Kingdom of Christ in the fullness of her spiritual and bodily existence. According to an old custom, flowers and medicinal herbs are blessed after the Divine Liturgy on the Feast of Dormition. According to traditional belief, after Mary's assumption, her tomb was fill with a "heavenly fragrance" and flowers. The herbs, used as natural medicine, are blessed in commemoration of the numerous healing and extraordinary graces bestowed on the pilgrims at Mary's tomb.

Blessing of flowers.

In the Byzantine Church we bless flowers on this feast, not simply because they were found in the tomb of the Virgin Mary, but because they are the seeds of next year's plantings. What we see in any bloom now is the seed of another one to come, and therefore a strong symbol of resurrection. The Icon of the Feast of the Dormition that is on the ceiling of our church shows Jesus Christ standing in the center looking at His mother. He is holding a small child clothed in white representing the soul of the Virgin Mary.
