Cataract Press is visiting our parish on Sunday, March 17 with a large selection of Ukrainian merchandise, including Easter items, books in Ukrainian and English, jewelry imported from Ukraine, embroidery and clothing. These items will be displayed in the church hall and available for purchase.

Prayer Service for Peace and Justice.

This past Thursday evening, hundreds of people attended a Prayer Service for Peace in Ukraine at the Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Philadelphia that was led by His Beatitude Sviatoslav and the bishops of the Permanent Synod. The American Ukrainian community in Perth Amboy, NJ has always been active, especially on appeals for peace and solidarity, support for the homeless, an emergency medical donation appeal and prayer for those suffering around the world.

On this special day, many parishioners on their own and Assumption Catholic School students, teachers, parish sisters and administration traveled by bus to Philadelphia to pray for the end of war and to show support for people of Ukraine, who are suffering after Russia's invasion into Ukraine. For the past two years, Assumption Catholic School has opened its doors to more than twenty Ukrainian refugee students as millions flee the war-torn country. The school is providing discounted tuition, language instruction and a sense of stability for the children.

Ukraine Humanitarian Assistance

Nearly every Ukrainian or American living in the USA has heard about large fundraisers for body armor, helmets, thermal imagers, quadcopters, scopes, vehicles, etc., organized by volunteer foundations. Both soldiers and volunteers say that drones are one of the key elements of military advantage today. However, high demand for drones may lead to an increase in their price.

We were recommended INFINITY DRONES CORP in Canada by volunteer Olga Lastovetska, consistently buying drones at a lower price in Canada and sending them to Ukraine.

With the logistic help of Olga and the generosity of Bohdan and Halyna Jasinski Family (Medical Career Institute) we were able to purchase three drones, DJI Mavic 3T for \$13,873.27 and successfully deliver them to Ukraine's Frontline Troops.

The following battalions received our purchased drones.

The celebration of the Liturgy dedicated to the Adoration of Holy Cross, the singing of the choir, the congregation participation and a wonderful homily of His Grace were truly a spiritual nourishment for all. The Divine Liturgy concluded with a greeting from the pastor and exclamations of "Many Years" for the bishop Benedict and singing of "Bozhe Velykyi," a Prayer for Ukraine.
