Question About Our Faith

- *Recently, someone asked me the question, "Why does the Catholic Church believe we are the "original" one?"*

A good question. Do you know why? Catholics believe the Catholic Church is the "original" church because it is the only one founded by Jesus Christ. What does that mean? Apostolic Succession means there is an unbroken papal line beginning with Saint Peter, who Jesus first called to lead the disciples and who began the foundation of the church we are part of today. This emphasizes divine continuity. Early Church tradition is the foundation of what has become widespread practices throughout Christianity. The role of the Roman See, with the Pope as Peter's successor, centralized Church authority. Doctrinal continuity means that teachings and practices align closely with early Christian doctrines, asserting spiritual and historical continuity. So, if someone should ask, now you know why we believe the Catholic Church is the "original" one.
