TODAY: The Eighth Sunday after Pentecost.

Why did Our Lord Jesus perform this great miracle of feeding over 5,000 people in today's Gospel? He wanted to prepare them for still another miracle, an even greater one, the one that He performed at the Last Supper, when He changed the substance of bread into His own Body. This He did when He blessed the bread, saying : "Take and eat: this is My Body," and changed the wine into His Precious Blood. He thus instituted the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, through which we today receive the spiritual nourishment necessary for our souls. Jesus Himself said: I am the Bread of Life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst." The Holy Eucharist is the most important of the seven sacraments because, in this and in no other sacrament, we receive the very body and blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ.

The Catechism on the EUCHARIST.

"The Eucharist is the heart and the summit of the Church's life, for in it Christ associates his Church and all her members with his sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving offered once for all on the cross to his Father; by this sacrifice he pours out the graces of salvation on his Body which is the Church" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1407). "It is Christ himself, the eternal high priest of the New Covenant who, acting through the ministry of the priests, offers the Eucharistic sacrifice. And it is the same Christ, really present under the species of bread and wine, who is the offering of the Eucharistic sacrifice" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1410).

<u>QUESTIONS on Catholic spirituality, moral & spiritual</u> <u>problems</u>

• How long before the Divine Liturgy should we abstain from eating?

The Church requires that we abstain from eating for one hour before receiving the Eucharist (CCC 1387). Technically, you could eat something before a longer Divine Liturgy and still receive the Eucharist, as long as communion time was an hour after you ate. The point of the Eucharistic Fast is to prepare us to receive Jesus with greater yearning. Fasting prior to the Divine Liturgy is the appropriate way to prepare ourselves for receiving Jesus. It just doesn't seem right to have a chocolate doughnut or a cheeseburger in our stomachs just a few minutes before we receive the Creator of the universe. Also, you should refrain from chewing gum.

• Is it okay to date divorced men? I'm widowed and haven't begun dating yet. I'm in my mid-40s, and so most "single" men my age are divorced. I know, understand, and believe the Church's teaching on the indissolubility of marriage, and that leads me to question whether it would be moral to date a man who is divorced (unless his marriage was declared null by the Church).

If a divorced person does not have an annulment for his previous marriage, the Church presumes him to be married. Because you must presume him to be married unless and until he obtains an annulment, you should not pursue any kind of romantic relationship with those who are divorced and without annulments from the Church.
