Although independent Ukraine appeared on the
political map of the world relatively recently, the history
of the Ukrainian nation goes back more than a thousand
years. Deeply rooted in the traditions of the medieval
Kievan Rus and later of the Cossack republic, the
Ukrainians throughout their long history strived for their
own state, free from occupation or colonization by a
neighboring people.

Nowadays, as Ukraine entered the third year of
repelling full-scale Russian aggression, Independence
Day has a special meaning to its people. It is the battle
for our own existence, for the freedom to live on our
own land and speak our own language, freedom to
choose our own future.

The price being paid for these simple universal
rights is very high. The war has taken away many
precious lives of Ukraine's best, most dedicated, and
courageous patriots at the front, and thousands of
innocent civilians.

This August 24th, let us recommit ourselves to
helping Ukraine reclaim full sovereignty over its
international borders, by providing Ukraine's heroes all
the assistance they need to defend their freedoms and
let us pray that the good Lord safeguards the Ukrainian
people and grants them the strength to secure their
sovereignty, the fortitude to restore their territorial
integrity.
