Pastor's Corner: Church Etiquette Entering and Leaving During the Service.

Except in the case of an emergency it is disrespectful to enter or leave the service during the readings of the Epistle and Gospel, the homily/sermon, or anytime that the Body and Blood of Christ are in the Nave (e.g. during the distribution of Holy Communion).

On some Sundays, it almost seems like we have a revolving door in the back of the church-and it is used by both children and adults. Use the restroom before coming to church. You shouldn't need to get a drink of water during the service (especially if you are taking Communion!). Don't come to church to go to the fellowship hall—come to pray. Taking restless little ones out is a different matter. If a child is disruptive, take him/her quickly and quietly out of church, just long enough to settle him down, then return to
