Tomorrow is a STRICT DAY OF FAST & ABSTINENCE..... The faithful are expected to abstain from eating foods which contain meat, poultry, eggs and dairy products, as well as eat lighter meals. All Fridays are also days of fast and abstinence. Many people include Wednesdays as days of fast and abstinence during Lent.

Those exempt from this fast:

• Children under 8 and adults over 65, pregnant women, nursing mothers and those who are ill.
