Prayer for Kidnapped Children of Ukraine.

Sunday, June 1st is International Children’s Day and the Ukrainian National Women’s League of America (UNWLA) Branch #135 invites all children of our parish to pray for the thousands of Ukrainian children who have been forcibly removed from their homes, transferred to Russia, placed in so-called “re-education” camps, or had their identities changed and put up for adoption. We ask children to wear Ukrainian embroidered shirts and sit in the front pews at the 9:00 am Sunday Liturgy.

We welcome back our Sister Trijtsi and Sister Svitanku, who have returned from Ukraine, where they made their Final Profession of Vows as Sisters Servants of the Lord and the Virgin of Matará.

The Final Profession of Vows, also known as perpetual vows, is a formal ceremony in which a religious sister publicly commits to living out her vocation—through the vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience—for the rest of her life.
