Parable of the Pharisee and the Publican.

Today’s gospel story occurs in the Holy Gospel according to Luke the Evangelist (18.10-14).

In our Savior’s parable, Jesus uses a Pharisee, a leader of the synagogue who was regarded in public opinion as virtuous, and a publican, a tax collector who was regarded as oppressive, greedy and a sinner. In their prayers to God, we discover the real hearts of these two men. We thus learn of the harm that comes from pride and the good that comes from humility.

The godly Church Fathers sought to alert and prepare the Christ-loving clergy and laity for the upcoming period of the Great Fast.

Therefore, on this Sunday we are reminded that humility is the greatest weapon against pride, as we imitate the humility of the publican to ascend to the divine heights.

To the parents of our young children may we suggest...

Relax! If a parish isn’t crying, it’s dying.

Silence has its place in church, but don’t forget that ‘God put the wiggle in children; don’t feel you have to suppress it in God’s house.

But do prevent them from kicking people in the pews or playing in the confessional booth at the back of the church. Don’t be afraid to sit towards the front where it is easier to see and hear. Quietly explain the parts of the Liturgy to your children. Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behaviours by copying you. If you need to leave Liturgy with your child, please feel free to do so, but please come back. You can also take advantage of the “cry room”. Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to Church, to God and to Christ.

Let them know that they are at home in this sacred space. Do your best to attend Liturgy on time. In fact I would love it if you and your child would come up to me at the Coffee Hour and give me a “high five”. When kids know the priest they feel more comfortable. To the members of our parish... A smile of encouragement is always welcome to parents with small, active children.
