TODAY: The Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32)

The Parable of the Prodigal Son reveals God’s boundless mercy and unconditional love. Like the son, we may turn away from God, but He never stops loving us or waiting for our return. Through repentance and faith, we are welcomed back, not by force but by a personal choice to return. God’s forgiveness is freely given because Jesus has paid the price for our reconciliation through the Cross. The Father’s joyful welcome shows that God longs to forgive, restore, and draw us into communion with Him, without fear, offering us new life in His everlasting kingdom.

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord.

At the heart of this feast is the meeting of the righteous Simeon and the prophetess Anna with the infant Jesus. Simeon proclaims Christ as the “Light to enlighten the nations.”

For this reason, candles are blessed on this day as a symbol of Christ, the Light of the World.

Following this week’s liturgies, Father will bless candles made of natural beeswax, fragrant with honey, and crafted in a monastery. They burn evenly with a bright, clean flame.
