Sunday of Meatfare (Sunday of the Last Judgment)

The Sunday is also called the Sunday of the Last Judgment. On this day, we are powerfully reminded that no one is as merciful as God; yet even He does not forgive those who do not repent. If our hearts remain hardened and unrepentant, we should not expect the Lord to overlook our transgressions simply because He is good and loving.

Our salvation and final judgment will depend upon our deeds, not merely upon our intentions. God will judge us not only for the wrong we have done, but also for the good we have failed to do. By recalling the manner in which the Last Judgment will be carried out, this service is intended to fill us with salutary fear, sorrow for our sins, and to stress the importance of good works—especially works of mercy.

Sorokousty Lenten Memorial Service

In the Ukrainian Catholic Church, it is the custom to remember our beloved dead during the time of the Great Fast. The Great Fast begins on Monday, February 23rd, 2026. These commemorations occur on Saturdays because the Saviour of the world rested in the grave on Great and Holy Saturday, awaiting the Resurrection.

Thus, Saturday became for Christians the day for commemorating the deceased, who await the resurrection on the last day.

Please take the time to remember your deceased family members on the Saturdays of the Great Fast. They hope for our prayers; and in turn, they pray for us.
