TODAY: Cheesefare Sunday.

This Sunday is also known as Forgiveness Sunday, is the final day before the beginning of Great Lent. On this day, the Church calls us to embrace forgiveness, humility, and repentance as we prepare for the spiritual journey of fasting. In the Gospel reading of today we are reminded that we cannot enter Lent carrying resentment or unforgiveness.

Upcoming Parish Events.

- Sunday, February 22 at 11:00 a.m. in the church hall watch the Film "Palianytsia". We invite parishioners to join the international film marathon "Culture vs War," held in commemoration of the fourth anniversary of Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine. The film "Palianytsia" (2025), directed by Kadim Tarasov, with a running time of 64 minutes. The film begins as a journey of two American street-art artists to Ukraine to make sense of what is happening, and gradually becomes a tool for conveying the truth about the war—a form of resistance that calls for deep reflection: "Who am I? What am I worth? And which side am I on?" Voluntary donations collected during the screening will go to support Ukraine, specifically the needs of soldiers and the wounded.
